

THE HAMLET OF L'ÂNERIE

Join the hamlet of "L'Ânerie" with its typical rural houses.



Then stop at the Moulin de Buglais, built in the 16th century by the monks of the Abbey of Saint-Jacut (guided tour in season with the Tourist Office).

to pass in front of the Maison de la Culture et des Loisirs Eugène Coualan, rue Julien Renault.

THE HAMLET OF LA **METTRIE**

Continue to the hamlet of La Mettrie is the limit between the towns of Lancieux and Beaussais sur Mer.





LE POINT CULMINANT

Go up to the rue de Bodard to reach the highest point of Lancieux (47m), the mound of the Moulin de la Roche, to benefit from a unique point of view.



Helmet compulsory for children under 12.

Drive in single file and obey the highway

THE TOWN CENTER

Turn right towards bd de Buglais then bd Maséra to reach the town center, its shops and the old bell tower dating from 1740 then take the rue du center and carefully cross the RD departmental road).





THE BANKS OF THE FRÉMUR

Take rue Henri Samson and explore the banks of the Frémur (river separating Lancieux and Saint-Briac-sur-Mer and between the departments of Côtes d'Armor and Ille-et-Vilaine).





THE ACCOMMODATION CENTER

Pass in front of the Frémur accommodation center which welcomes groups from the Nautical Club and hikers among others.





THE ROCHEGOUDE MILL

Go to the Rochegoude mill, private property. This tidal mill dates from 1775 and operated until 1958.
